THE DIRECTOR

Seth A Smith is a Canadian interdisciplinary artist working in film, music, sound design, and printmaking. His films frequent top genre festivals around the world and are praised for their visually rich, surrealist style. His first, LOWLIFE, was boldly named "the most original feature debut in East Coast cinematic history" by the Atlantic International Film Festival. Since, he's produced two more — THE CRESCENT premiered at TIFF in 2017, and just recently, TIN CAN premiered at SITGES in 2020. Smith is currently developing an adaptation of Algernon Blackwood's THE WILLOWS, and an animated fantasy epic called BESHADER. Outside of filmmaking, Smith is known for his music in DOG DAY, and his visual art in YORODEO.

ABOUT THE FILM

DUST BATH was done using rotoscoping, a technique where captured video footage is referenced and illustrated over creating a hybrid medium of live action and animation. The actors in this film are Smith's own backyard, free range chickens. During filming, he followed them around for a week to document their secret language and habits. No animals were hurt during the making of this film, but sadly, a few months after the shoot, Lennart, the rooster, was taken by an eagle.
